**Daily sunshine hours in June/December (average):** The wettest month is *June* with an *average* of 90mm of *rain*. The average temperature in Brussels in December is cool at 3.5 °C (38.3 °F).

**Weather:** Belgium is a West European country with a typical sea-climate. It's never very cold or hot, never very dry either. There is a lot of rainfall, and in spring/autumn there might be rain for days. For all tourist attractions and cities, some sun does wonders. So May to September are better than the winter months, although the art cities (Bruges, Antwerp, Gent, Leuven) can be enjoyed year round. In theory, one can ski in Belgium but this is to be avoided: there are no decent slopes, no decent material is for rent in the 'resorts', and there is only enough snow for 0 to 10 days per year.
